THE WORD OF GOD IS THE GUIDE FOR OUR PROGRAM'S STRUCTURE, REGULATIONS, & DISCIPLINES THAT ARE DESIGNED TO LEAD MEN TO LEARN TO THINK AND ACT DIFFERENTLY AS THEY BECOME NEW MEN CHRIST.

Liberty Program students are encouraged to maintain a high level of integrity, participate in group study sessions, counseling sessions, Bible Studies, and Church activities. Students also serve within our ministry, assisting with meeting the needs of the less fortunate in our area and hopefully growing tremendously both spiritually and emotionally. Students are also expected to demonstrate responsibility and initiative in being willing to take instructions as well as instructing others as needed. Students are under supervision of our staff both at the CSI center in Hattiesburg and at the Land of Liberty campus in Ellisville.

Liberty Ministry students come from all walks of life. Referrals include court systems, mental health providers, MDOC, churches, rehabilitation centers, self, and family referrals. CSI asks for a \$1000 induction fee to cover all program and individual costs of the 1 year program.

We strive to serve ALL individuals who are looking to break the chains and cycles of addictions, life binding situations, and those who want to grow closer to Jesus in a controlled living environment.

FOUNDATION (PHASE ONE)

THIS FIRST PHASE OF THE PROGRAM IS A FOUNDATIONAL FOUR-SIX MONTH EVALUATION PERIOD WITH LIBERTY MINISTRIES WHICH CONSISTS OF:

- FOURTEEN WEEKS OF BIBLICAL GROUP STUDIES
- INDIVIDUAL CONTRACT OF BIBLE/PERSONAL STUDIES
- WORK THERAPY
- MENTORING
- GUIDANCE/COUNSELING

DURING THIS TIME, THE STUDENT WILL BE EXPECTED TO SHOW WILLINGNESS AND ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN THE LIFE REFORMATION PROCESS EVIDENCED BY THEIR WORK AND COMMUNICATIONS WITH OTHER STUDENTS AND STAFF. THE LIBERTY MINISTRY DIRECTOR WILL DETERMINE WHEN THE STUDENT WILL BE ADVANCED TO THE SECOND PHASE.

IDENTIFY THE THINGS IN THEIR LIFE THAT HINDER THEM FROM LIVING A PRODUCTIVE LIFE.

FORMATION (PHASE TWO)

THE SECOND PHASE IS ADVANCED PROGRAM WHICH CONSISTS OF:

- ONE PERSONAL CONTRACT OF BIBLE/PERSONALITY STUDIES
- ADDITIONAL VISITATIONS AND FAMILY RESTORATION
- CONTINUED WORK THERAPY
- CONTINUED COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE
- MENTOR SELECTION
- INDIVIDUAL LIFE PLAN GOALS

AFTERCARE

- THE STUDENT MAY CHOOSE TO REMAIN AT CHRISTIAN SERVICES IN AN INTERIM STAFF POSITION, TAKING ON MORE RESPONSIBILITY AND PREPARING HIMSELF TO TRANSITION INTO TRADITIONAL LIVING.
- THE STUDENT MAY LEAVE CHRISTIAN SERVICES AND RETURN TO HIS HOME OR OTHER DOMICILE, OR PARTNER SOBER LIVING RESIDENCES AND FOR SIX MONTHS REPORT ON A MONTHLY BASIS CONCERNING HIS EMPLOYMENT, CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS.

AT THE SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF PHASE TWO, THE STUDENT WILL BE GRADUATED AND CONSIDERED HAVING COMPLETED THE PROGRAM.

THE LIBERTY PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO FACILITATE A LIFE-STYLE CHANGE THROUGH FIVE AREAS OF DAY-TO-DAY HABITS AND PRACTICES:

**STRUCTURED ENVIRONMENT *STRONG DISCIPLINE *IN-DEPTH INTROSPECTIVE BIBLE STUDIES
*REGULAR CHURCH ATTENDANCE *COMMUNITY SERVICE TO THE LESS FORTUNATE*
